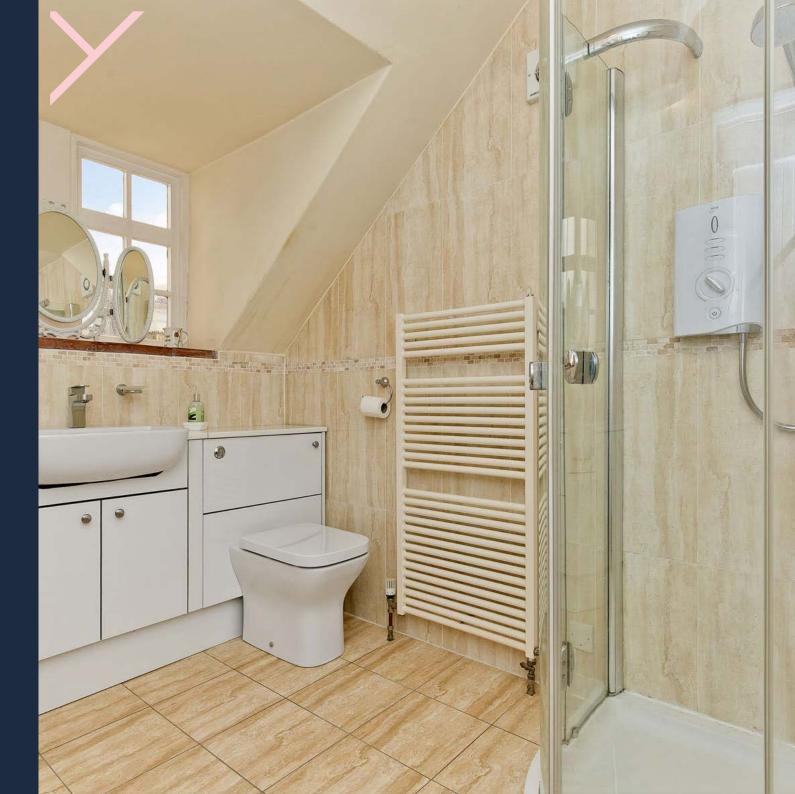

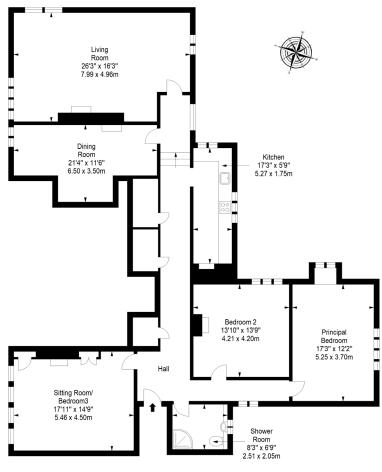
floorplan
